

TERMS AND CONDITIONS for Outdoor Theatre at Abergavenny Castle

WHEN YOU BOOK TICKETS:

- Tickets can only be purchased online on this site. **The last booking time will be 3 hours before the start of the performance.**
- Please either print out proof of ticket purchase at home and bring with you on the day, or have the booking available on your mobile phone to show – this will be your ticket for entry.
- No tickets will be available for sale on site.
- If for any reason the Show has to be cancelled your ticket costs will be refunded.
- Once tickets are bought they are non-refundable except in the event of cancellation.

WHAT TO BRING WITH:

- **Print out of your ticket booking or a mobile phone with proof of booking**
- Your own seating – preferably low backed chairs – these will give you the best view, (or rugs and cushions)
- You are most welcome to bring a picnic. Refreshments will not be on sale at the Castle during the event, so please make sure you have water etc especially if the weather is hot.
- Rubbish bag – we are asking you this year, please to take home all the waste from your picnic, especially cutlery, plates and cups, serviettes tissues etc - please do not leave it at the site
- Please bring/wear appropriate clothing etc for walking on the grass and sitting outdoors. Even if it's a hot day it can get cool once the sun goes down, so please bring warm clothing for later. Bring waterproofs if the weather is doubtful or rain forecast.
- Check the weather forecast – bring sun lotion if it's hot and sunny. Bring waterproofs if rain is forecast. You can bring an umbrella – but please be mindful of other members of the audience and don't block their view...
- You may want to bring your own sanitiser and wipes. The toilet facilities available will be the public toilets in the nearby Car Park

AT ABERGAVENNY CASTLE:

- Please arrive no earlier than 45 minutes before the start of the show, and no later than 15 minutes before the start.

REFUND POLICY

- Tickets are non-refundable except in the event of cancellation.

FAQs

Can we bring dogs as its outside?

Unfortunately, dogs aren't allowed in the castle grounds

Will there be buggy storage?

No we ask you to keep your buggy with you.

Will there be a disabled seating area?

No. There is disabled access to the site, but please be aware that the performance and seating area is on grass.

What about the weather?

The company do the show in the rain though a storm or hurricane would stop the action. We advise you to dress and prepare appropriately as its one of the unique pleasures of outdoor theatre in the Welsh summer.
