Tintern Visitor Experience Survey Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

How to enter

- 1. The prize draw is free to enter and no purchase is necessary, but completion of the survey questionnaire and provision of a valid email address are requirements to be entered into the prize draw.
- 2. Entries received after the stated closing date will not be accepted.
- 3. Monmouthshire County Council will not accept responsibility for entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

Eligibility
