Accessibility / Terrain

No of Stiles: 9

Varied terrain including rough woodland paths, farmland, quiet lanes. Several steep sections.

Walk this route clockwise, so the steepest section (Wye Valley Walk in Black Cliff Wood) is taken uphill.

Brief Route Details / Points of Particular Interest

The route heads out of Tintern above the Abbey, following the Wye Valley Walk up into dense woodland. Leaving the wood you cross a mix of farmland and quiet lanes and climb steadily to Gaer Hill with its fabulous views over Chepstow, the Severn Estuary and farther afield to England. You now descend to Penterry Church, then through a succession of open fields, lanes and tracks through lush woodland back down into Tintern.

Points of interest include industrial archeology at the Lower Wireworks, Penterry Church, Gaer Hill Fort, Tintern Lime Kilns and views of Tintern Abbey.
