### **Brief Route Details / Points of Particular Interest**

Starting from St Teilo's Church, this route passes Hen Gwrt, the site of a moated manor house, and crosses fields to join a section of the Three Castles Walk as it rises to White Castle. The return route follows the Offa's Dyke Path National Trail down a narrow lane and back across fields.
